


The children have had another lovely week in school.

## myHappymind School

Nurturing hearts and minds is at the core of what we do at St. Gabriel's so we have been really excited about introducing a program to all year groups at school called my Happymind. myHappymind is all based around helping children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves! To further embed this learning and ensure that you are able to engage in these topics with your child, myHappymind has developed a set of resources for parents. These resources can be accessed online on your computer, or through an app on your phone. The resources allow children to continue to practise some of the habits they have developed at school, such as happy breathing, and for you to learn more about what they are learning in the program.
