Dear Parents/Carers,

From previous letters sent this week, you will know that Cheshire East is experiencing significantly high levels of infection re Covid. The rate of infection is well above the national with 585.8 per 100,00 as of 14 Oct. This is very alarming, with the rate of children aged 10-15 being over 2200 per 100,000. Thankfully our own rates of infection appear to be falling so let's hope that continues. We continue to have good hand hygiene practice and ventilation providing air flow throughout the school. It is very clear that we are all having to manage the situation as best as we can. Please remain safe and aware of any potential infection risk.

I am aware of difficulties that arose from parent meetings held yesterday. We are looking into these as a matter of urgency. If the meeting did not go ahead, we are seeking another time for these to take place. Those of you with meetings arranged for Monday, log into Teams using your child's log in (as previously). Go to calendar and you should find a meeting to join for your allocated time. NB: Only one person can log into your child's account, so if two parents wish to join from separate places, the meeting link will need to be copied by one of you and forwarded to the parent to join via the web.

A heartfelt thank you too for all of your kind messages of support whilst I was absent and in speaking with you since. It has certainly been a mad few weeks!
