'Nurturing Hearts and Minds'

Dear Parents and Carers,

I trust the Christmas break was kind and peaceful to you all.

Challenges of Covid hit us on the first day back and have continued throughout these first few weeks. Guidance changed several times in that first week as we all tried to get to grips with changes in isolation procedures and communicating these quickly as we were being informed of more infections. As it stands, one class have several infections higher than others and we have 'bubbled' them for 5 days to try and restrict the possible spread to other classes and staff. All this is happening as national restrictions are being removed, but please note infections in Cheshire East are still high, against the national figures where they are decreasing, but the 4-11 age group is still increasing in CE. Whilst the restrictions within the national guidance are being removed, which is good news... we still must manage the infection rate to keep the school functioning as effectively as we can. We have been affected by staff absence already so it is vital we do all we can to prevent risk. In summary, the advice we are following from CE...

- 1. Test regularly. If positive, you must isolate for at least 5 days dependent on negative results on day 5 and 6. If one remains positive, you must isolate until you have 2 consecutive negative results 24hrs apart. You may still have to isolate for 10 days.
- 2. If you have symptoms, get a PCR test. Book online <u>Get tested for coronavirus (COVID-19) NHS (www.nhs.uk)</u>
- 3. If someone in your household tests positive, the 5-day isolation for pupils still stands until further notice and they must test daily for 5 days after that. Tests can be booked online. Order coronavirus (COVID-19) rapid lateral flow tests GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

It is clear the aim is to manage the infection and live with it, like any other infection. We must still take care of ourselves and each other. Please, keep safe.
