### **Christmas holidays-Covid 19**

- If any member of your household is displaying any of the 3 main Covid
   19 symptoms you must seek a test and all self-isolate and await the test results.
- Your child must only get a Covid19 test if they have any of the 3 main symptoms.

If your child <u>develops symptoms on or up to Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> December</u>, you must inform us <u>as soon as</u> you have test results so that we can contact parents within the class/bubble and advise them that they must self-isolate. We will access the email account <u>head@stgabriels.cheshire.sch.uk</u> up to and including December 24<sup>th</sup>.

If your child <u>develops symptoms from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December</u> <u>onwards</u>, you must inform us as soon as you have the test results, but we will not need to contact any parents or families as close contacts to advise them of the need to self-isolate.
