

In the prayer bag you will find the following items:

- An instruction card/ script explaining how to use the resources and what to say
- A cloth- to represent special days in the church, such as saints' feast days
- · A holding cross- to remind us of Jesus' sacrifice
- · A candle- to remind us that Jesus is the light of the world
- Holy water- reminding us of our Baptism
- Prayer journal to record thoughts on your family prayer time (you could include a photo and either you or your child could write a short reflection)

We do hope that you enjoy spending time together in prayer and look forward to hearing about your prayer experience together.
