Please remember these children in your prayers as they continue to learn more about their faith and develop their personal relationship with God.







#### **Parent Survey**

I would like to thank you for your overwhelmingly positive responses to the recent survey.

The results were extremely pleasing and confirms what a wonderful school family we have at St Gabriel's. We very much value your thoughts and we are always looking at how to improve. It is so pleasing to know that 100% of parents feel that they are welcome in school and that their children are happy at school. Whilst the survey was incredibly positive there were a couple of minor issues raised;

- Parents prefer teacher consultations face to face rather than online. As a result, the spring term parents consultations will be face to face.
- Some parents would like the office to be open later. This is something that we are looking into.
- Whilst most parents appreciated the increased opportunities in extra-curricular activities provided this year, some parents felt that there should be more provision. At present, we have 19 extra-curricular clubs, and whilst we will endeavour to increase the provision, there is however limited space in school.

The children are very excited and have really enjoyed playing on it.
