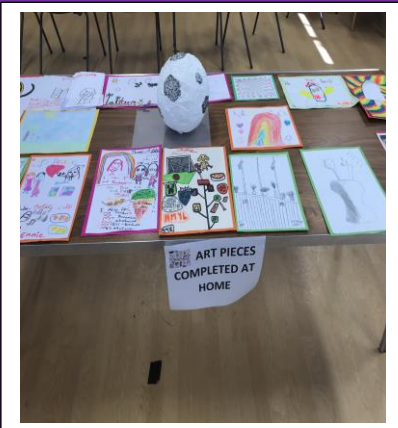

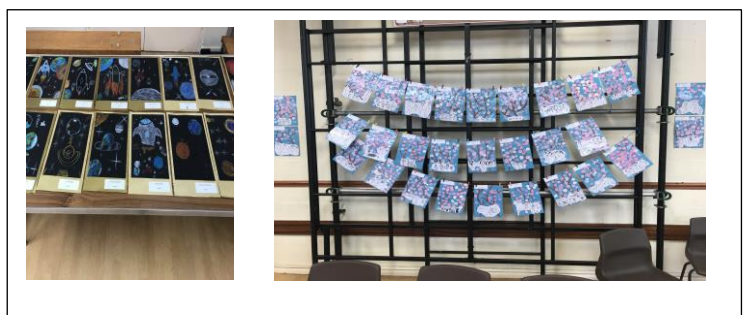
Friday 31st March 2023

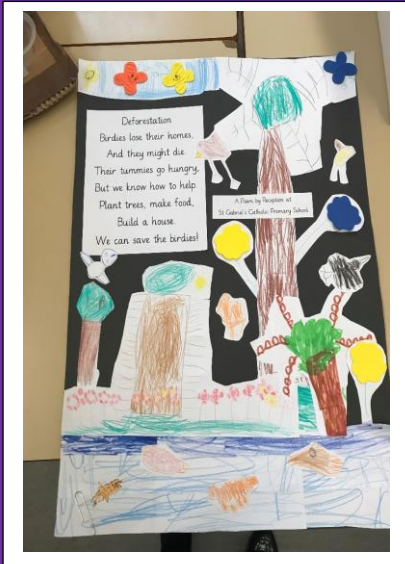

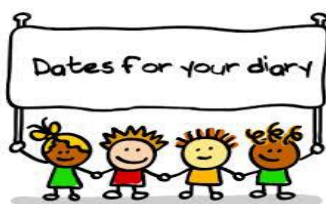
