

Parent surveys produced an extremely positive result. 82 parents responded out of 161 families. There are a number of findings that we can celebrate;

100% of parents feel that their children are well looked after in school

100 % of parents feel welcome in school

100% of parents feel that the school is well lead and managed.

99% of parents feel that our school achieves high standards of behaviour

99% of parents would recommend our school to other parents

98% of parents feel that their child is happy and enjoys school

95 % of parents find it easy to approach the school



98% of parents say their child feels safe in school

93% of parents feel that their children make good progress at school

88% of parents feel that their children receive an adequate amount of homework

98% parents know how to help their children with homework

96% parents are happy with reading books/materials children bring home

96% of parents feel that their child is taught well in school.

89% of parents feel that there are sufficient extra - curricular activities available

94% of parents feel that school deals effectively with bullying
