

Parking

I understand and have seen for myself some of the issues with parking and traffic most mornings and drop off times. Please park considerably and safely. We have used an 'unofficial' I-way system for many years which can help the traffic flow. See diagram on next page.) To approach the school, please follow Cedar Avenue and then you can exit driving up Well Lane towards Station Road. Thank you. Parking further away and walking may actually be quicker in some cases. We are looking to improve the road markings and we will be able to zone off areas very close to the school to avoid vehicles parking and obstructing the flow of traffic. There is no immediate solution sadly, but we can just be mindful of the difficulties and the need to keep everyone safe, children, parents, pedestrians and residents.
