

Parent surveys produced an extremely positive result. 74 parents responded out of 161 families. Whilst the survey was in the main positive, there were several areas that require some action.

Evidence/Parent comment	Action
Communication - Some parents feel that communication from office staff regarding absence and illness could be improved.	There will not always be a response to emails if it is regarding absence, only where necessary e.g. if ongoing. Letting us know via email or message via school spider is always encouraged to prevent a first day absence phone call.
Fundraising - Some parents suggested a PTA to help with fundraising and for more fun activities for the children.	The formation of PTA can be of value, however we are fortunate to have an active group of parents who continually support fundraising efforts. We publicised a fundraising meeting on 29 February for parents to attend and discuss possible future events. Any support for various events, no matter how little, is always welcomed.
Some parents would like to use school spider payment for more activities.	School spider is available for all payments within school. If you are experiencing any issues here, please contact Mrs A. Stevenson at Reception.
4. Lunch time staff to monitor lunches.	We often have lunchtime staff to monitor the lunch habits of children. If you are concerned about your child not eating their lunches, please do not hesitate to contact us.
