Traffic and Parking

If you are a new parent to St Gabriel's, you will quickly realise that the roads around the school can become congested very easily around drop off and pick up times.

We suggest keeping Well Lane to an 'informal' I-way system whereby entering along Cedar Avenue and driving up Well Lane to the Station Road junction. It isn't perfect but I know if we all follow this it can help avoid further problems with congestion. If a car comes 'down' Well Lane at this time it does cause further headaches. We try really hard to keep disruption to a minimum, thus helping our residents and neighbours.
