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Christmas Holidays-Covid 19

- If any member of your household is displaying any of the 3 main Covid 19 symptoms you must seek a test and all self-isolate and await the test results.
- Your child must only get a Covid19 test if they have any of the 3 main symptoms.

If your child <u>develops symptoms on or up to Sunday 20th December</u>, you must inform us <u>as soon as</u> you have test results so that we can contact parents within the class/bubble and advise them that they must selfisolate. We will access the email account <u>head@stgabriels.cheshire.sch.uk</u> up to and including December 24th.

If your child <u>develops symptoms from Monday 21st December</u> <u>onwards</u>, you must inform us as soon as you have the test results, but we will not need to contact any parents or families as close contacts to advise them of the need to self-isolate.

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Booking for Christmas Masses

In order to comply with government guidelines to keep us all safe and well during the pandemic, if you would like to attend one of the Masses at Christmas, you will need to book a seat in advance.

Masses are at the following times:

24th December - Christmas Eve: 3 pm; 6.30 pm; (Bookings Needed)

25th December - Christmas Day: 9.30 am; (Bookings Needed)

11.00 am in St. Gabriel's School Playground (no bookings necessary for last open-air mass)

Please book for your own household only

You can make a booking either

- in person at one of the Masses on Saturday 19th, Sunday 20th and Monday 21st December;
- on the phone to Deacon Eddie, <u>07851376925</u> please leave a message if there is no reply

Please state:

- the first name, surname and telephone number of the person making the booking
- the date and time of the Mass you would like to attend, with alternatives in order of preference
- the number of seats required (maximum of 6 per household,)
- if anyone in your group has mobility difficulties

You will be allocated a numbered seat on a first come, first served basis; one seat number will be given per household.

You can collect your tickets before and after the Masses on Saturday 19th, Sunday 20th and Tuesday 22nd December or you can ask us to email your allocation to you.

Stewards will open the church doors half an hour before Mass starts. You will need to be in your allocated seat no later than 15 minutes before Mass starts. Any seats not taken by this time may be given to someone else.

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
